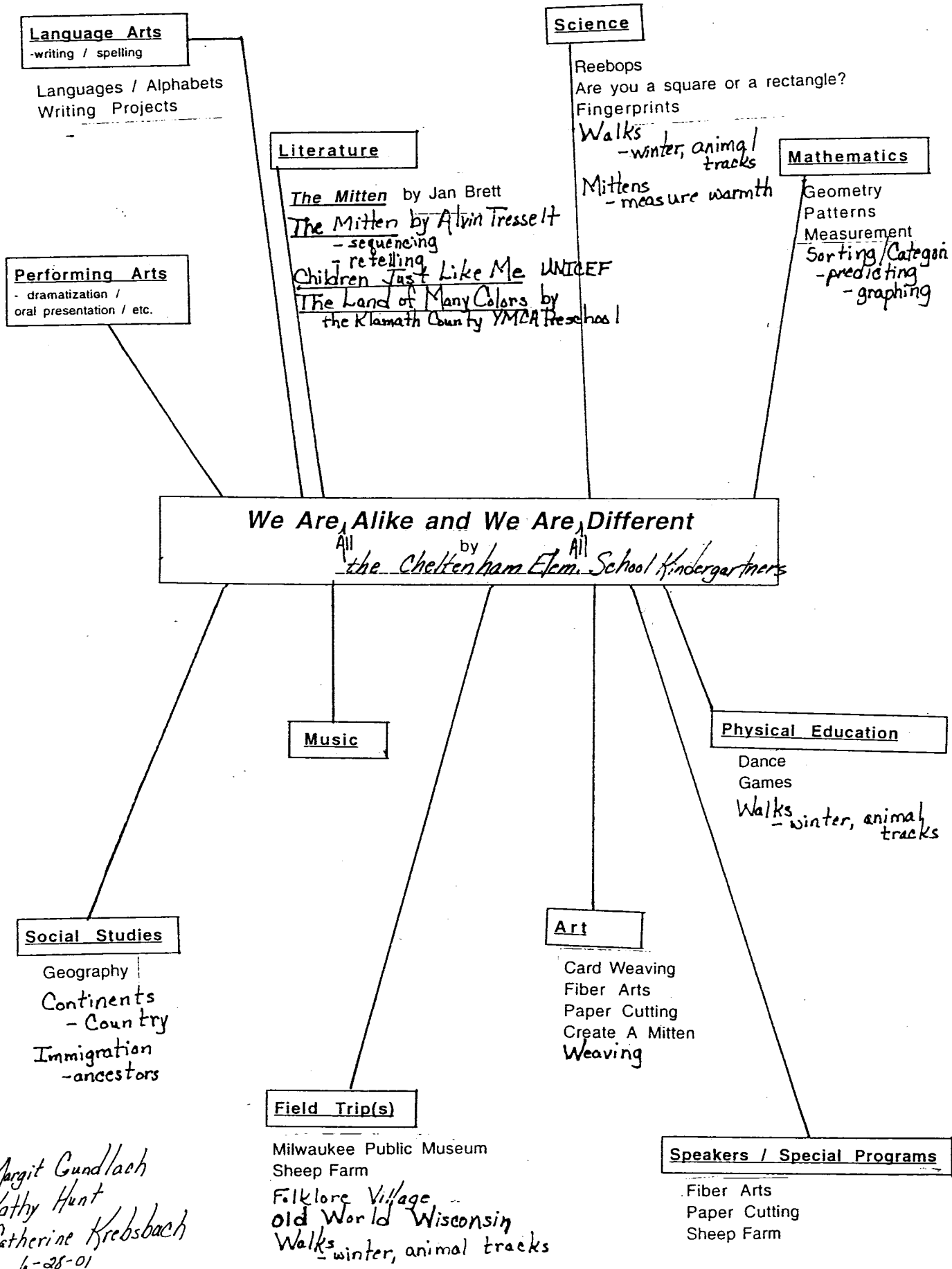
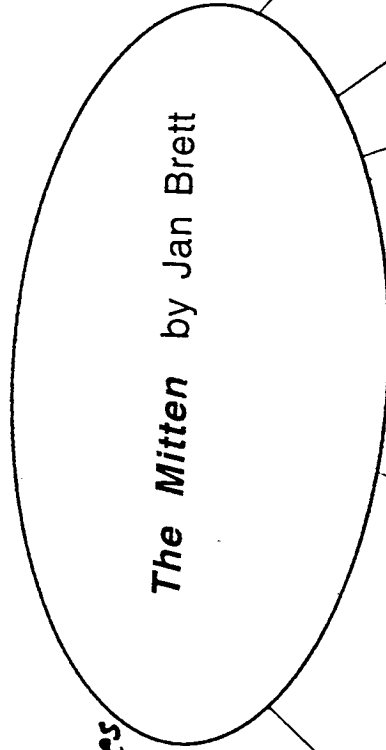


Goal - introduce learners to varied cultures, to encourage self-awareness and awareness of others; develop an appreciation of inter-relatedness

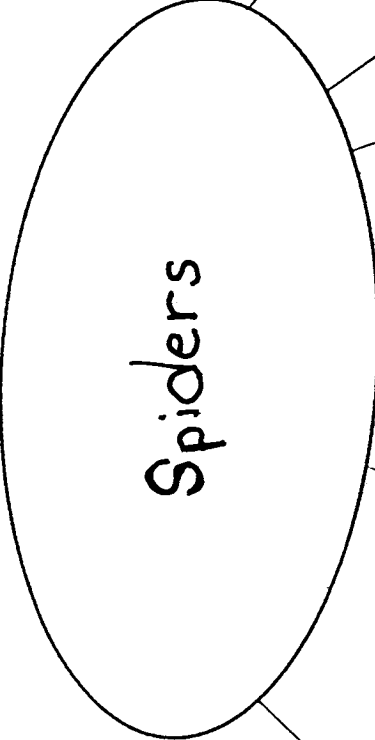


OBJECTIVES:

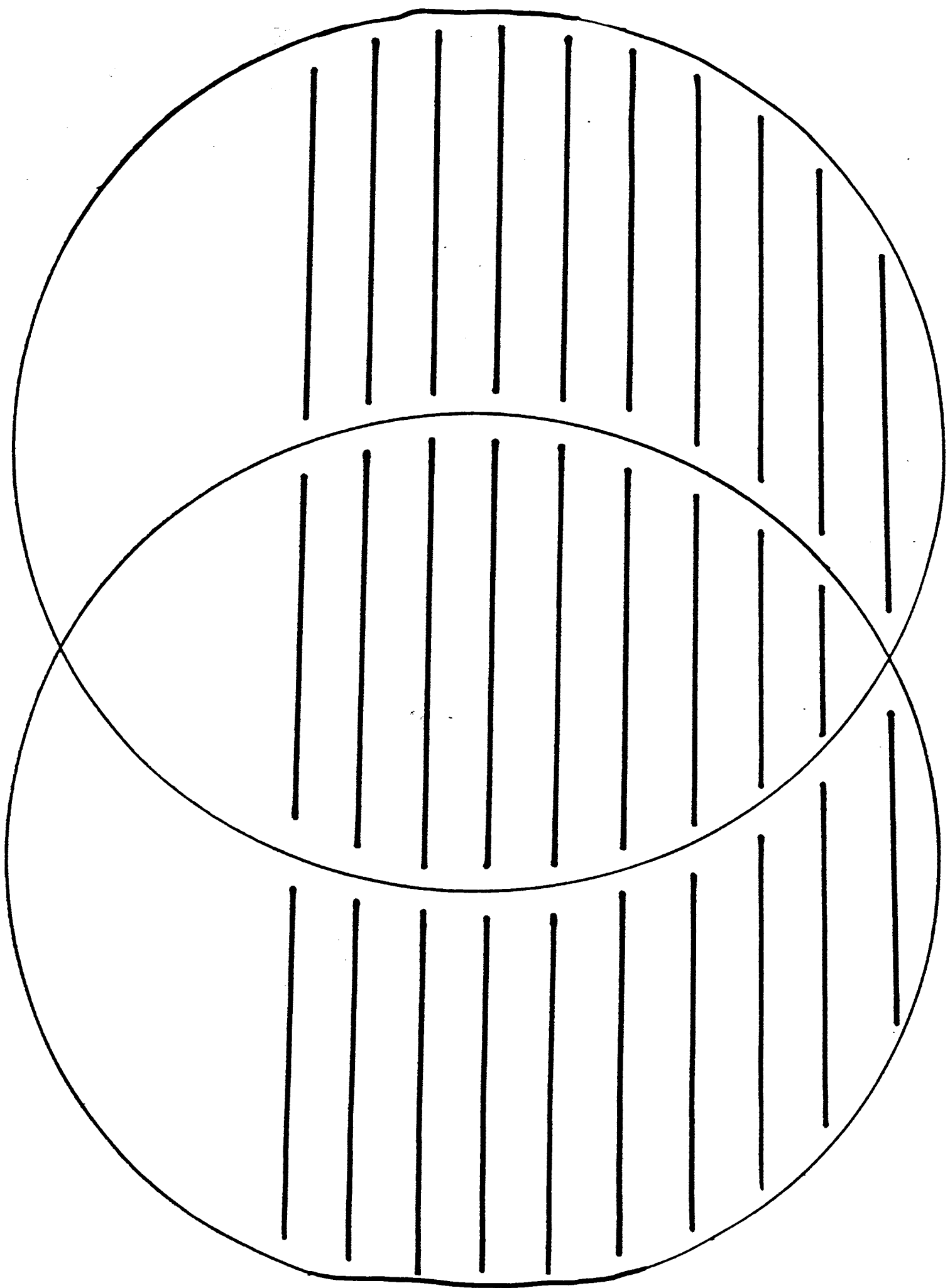
1. Expose students to varied genre

4. Integration of separate content area skills.

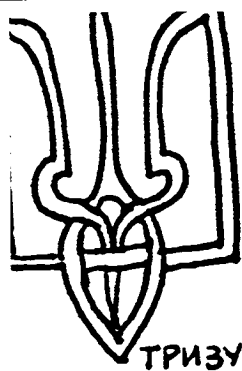
