The Russian House in the International Learning Community (ILC) in Adams Residence Hall invites applications for the position of residential Graduate Language Program Coordinator (GLPC) in the 2018-19 academic year.

Russian House is a language floor in the ILC for students with an interest in Russian language and culture. Residents gather at meals, cook Russian food, go to concerts of Russian music, visit the local Russian food store, watch Russian films, and chat in the hallways about daily life. The Russian House GLPC lives in Russian House during the academic year, working under the supervision of the Russian House Faculty Coordinator and the ILC Program Director to:

- Encourage and support Russian House residents in using Russian in the hall;
- Hold several events each week in Russian, including attending dinner with students in the dining hall;
- Organize monthly programs and activities for Russian House residents (minimum 1/month);
- Hold up to 4 hours/week of tutoring for Russian House residents;
- Provide assistance in recruiting students for the 1-credit ILC course, IS 310, taught by the Faculty Coordinator;
- Take the lead on developing one ILC dinner throughout the year;
- Provide programs for the entire ILC in collaboration with other ILC Graduate Language Program Coordinators twice/semester;
- Meet with the ILC Program Coordinator and/or Program Director bi-weekly;
- Attend ILC Steering Committee meetings (approx. once per semester);
- Attend training sessions at the beginning of the appointment with the ILC Program Coordinator to become familiar with Housing Policies, procedures, community building, community standards, and advising skills;
- Assist with the recruitment of new residents.

- Native or near-native (ACTFL Superior/Advanced High-level) speaker of Russian
- Experience teaching or mentoring undergraduates

Compensation: Compensation for the position of Russian House GLPC is comprised of room and board (\$2,000). The single room in Adams Residence Hall, provided to the GLPC at no cost, is in Adams Hall. The \$2,000 for board is paid through a deposit to the GLPC's UW Housing food account on WisCard.
